The AASC scholarship fund was created to give members an opportunity to attend conference education events who otherwise would be unable to participate because of financial limitations. The scholarship covers the cost of conference registration only; all hotel and travel expenses are the responsibility of the attendee.

- Written documentation proving financial hardship is required from the applicant's employer.
- Scholarships are available on a one-time basis only. Previous recipients are not eligible.
